First, let me say how much we appreciated the good help from contributors in the preparation and review of the draft analysis that became the Work Sheet for General Discussion. Also, our sincere thanks to participants in the two-day Working Conference on Forestry and Related Natural Resources of Hawaii. As you know, the College of Tropical Agriculture and Human Resources was asked by the Governor's Agriculture Coordinating Committee to provide the means and to facilitate analyses of Hawaii's industries and resources. This included the analysis of forestry and related natural resources.

To initiate this project, the College completed the draft analysis on February 28, 1980. Reviewers suggested changes and a revised draft was completed on June 30, 1980. This became the Work Sheet for General Discussion used in the Working Conference. The suggestions for changes that came from your Work Group sessions have been incorporated into the Analysis and the Action Sheet. Bottlenecks within Subject Areas have been listed in the priority order assigned by Work Groups. Subject Areas are arranged in the Action Sheet according to the overall priority order established during the plenary session of the Conference.

The Analysis displays Subject Areas in numerical order, I through XVII. The overall Subject Area priority assigned in the plenary session appears after the statement on Status of Knowledge, and bottlenecks follow in priority order.

Please review the Analysis and Action Sheet; if you see any discrepancies, omission, or unclear statements, send the information to Rudy Kallander, care of this office. We prefer to have your written comments; however, Rudy will

be available by phone on Friday, February 13, 1981. His number is 948-6733. If we do not hear from you by the deadline date of Monday, February 16, 1981, we will assume that you find the two documents acceptable.

The time of presentation of the Analysis and Action Sheet to the Governor's Agriculture Coordinating Committee is 1:30 p.m. on Wednesday, February 25, 1981. The place is the Governor's Conference Room on the fifth floor of the State Capitol. You are cordially invited and we sincerely hope you will be able to attend.
